

What are Ceramic Dental Implants?

Ceramic Dental Implants are designed differently than traditional metallic ones.



With a titanium implant, a two-piece model is always used. First, the root of the metal implant is set into the bone and later an abutment is screwed into place on top of it. If the small attachment breaks, the implant is extremely challenging to repair.

But a ceramic implant features a single-unit design that eliminates the internal connective components. Rather, it is a single piece, made out of the strongest ceramic possible.


When you elect to have a ceramic implant, you have the confidence of knowing there are no small screws or connections that can potentially fracture or fail. This characteristic alone makes them 2-3 times stronger than titanium designs.



What is Zirconia?

The DH Smile Center offers myMetal-Free line of solutions. These are for those who want no metal in their mouths.

We use Zirconia to produce life like restorations that can act as crowns and bridges.



Zirconia is a lightweight ceramic, that is incredibly strong – and resistant to bending, making it an ideal material for dental implants.

Its bright-white, tooth-like colour makes it all the more suitable for tooth replacement.

Zirconia does not corrode and is hypoallergenic.

If you tend to suffer from metal allergies (as with wearing certain types of jewelry) then a ceramic dental implant is a far safer choice when it comes to investing in smile rehabilitation.

Studies show that zirconia implants respond just as well during healing as — if not better than — titanium.

Natural

Ceramic dental implants are made of Zirconia, a pure white ceramic that is extremely biocompatible and does not corrode.

Metal dental implants have been used for decades in dentistry. However, they are not the most natural way of replacing teeth.

Their use often results in grey lines around the teeth and dark gums. Although the main metal used is titanium other metals in the implants can induce sensitivities, metals such as aluminum and nickel.

Ceramic dental implants are made of Zirconia, a pure white ceramic that is extremely biocompatible and does not corrode. Because of the white colour this material blends in and looks like a natural tooth, never having metal showing in the mouth and imparting a natural colour to thin gums.



Benefits of Ceramic Implants



Strong

Zirconia is one of the strongest ceramics available today. Zirconia implants are in fact 2-3 times stronger than the current titanium two piece implants.

Ceramic dental implants are made of a single piece of Zirconia. Zirconia is one of the strongest ceramics available today. Being one piece there are no small screws attaching components to the implant.

In titanium implants the alloy is strong but as a result of two-piece designs there are small screws that connect components and these screws can loosen or break over time.

Zirconia implants are in fact 2-3 times stronger than the current titanium two piece implants.



Benefits of Ceramic Implants



Healthy

Ceramic implants are made of a single piece without any connections that can grow bacteria. This is much healthier to the gum tissue.

Metal implants replacing teeth are comprised of two parts, the implant in the bone and the abutment in the mouth. The connection between these two components is a reservoir for oral bacteria.

This bacteria grows and multiplies under the gums and can lead to bad breath, gum disease and eventual destruction of the support for the implants.

Ceramic implants are made of a single piece that represents the part in bone and the part in the gum without any connections that can grow bacteria. This means that the ceramic implant is much healthier to the gum tissue and is more like a natural healthy tooth.



Advantages of Choosing Ceramic



If you have thinning gum tissues or worry about the possibility of a metal implant showing through between your gums and the restoration attached over it, you may want to shy away from a traditional titanium design.

With a ceramic implant, you can feel confident knowing that a continuous white color will extend all the way from the top of the tooth to the end of the implant. This prevents dark grey lines or shadows, providing you with a new “tooth” that blends seamlessly with your smile.

Because no metal shows through, ceramic implants offer the most aesthetic outcome when it comes to the final appearance of your smile makeover or rehabilitation.



Are Ceramic Implants for me?

You May Want to Consider Ceramic Implants if You...

- ✓ Like having a shining white smile
- ✓ Have thinning gum tissues or recession that may expose the implant
- ✓ Tend to develop allergies to certain metals (aluminum, nickel, etc.)
- ✓ Are worried about the possibility of dark shadows or metal showing when you smile
- ✓ Want the confidence of having the strongest implant design available
- ✓ Are making a conscious effort of lowering the bacterial levels within your mouth
- ✓ Have concerns over the risk of metal corrosion
